JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Junior Showmanship classes are for boy & girls who are at least 9 years old & under 18 years old on the day of the show.

<u>Novice Class:</u> For Juniors who, at the time entries close, <u>have not</u> three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class: For Juniors who, at the time entries close, <u>have</u> won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show

<u>Master Class</u>: For Juniors who, at the time entries close, have won 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition at a licensed or member show. All Juniors meeting the criteria for the class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the <u>front and back</u> of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

Winners of these class are **NOT** eligible to compete for Best of Breed

Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches may be altered and shown with two or more of their offspring. Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQ's/ excusals. Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch—off spring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class (National Only)

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants **MUST** be entered in another class.

AWARD OF MERIT: The judge may, at his/her discretion, give Awards of Merit to those dogs that were in final consideration for Best of Breed and were **not** winners of Best of Breed, Best opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Select Dog and Select Bitch. The number of awards is determined by the number of Best of Breed Competitors: 6-8 in BOB, 1 AOM, 9-12 in BOB, 2 AOM's; 12-15 in BOB 3 AOM's, 16 & over in BOB, 4 AOM's. A Rosette is offered by the Giant Schnauzer Club of America, Inc. and a spincast medallion will be given to commemorate the win.

3 POINT MAJOR - RESERVE WINNERS: In accordance with the recently approved change to Chapter 16, Section 1 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Show, at the 2024 national, Southern Regional and Midwest Regional Specialties, a dog designated Reserve Winners Dog or Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex total at least twice the number require for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included



PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884; the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- · Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- · The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- · The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- · Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- · Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
